FOREWORD

It is hoped that this revised edition of DP-35 will serve the Procurement Agencies to efficiently handle purchases of all types of defence equipment and provide better guidelines to the Suppliers to cater for the requirements of defence services.

I am aware that such documents can never be final and complete and, therefore, changes when necessitated because of the changed environments and conditions will continue to be incorporated after approval of the competent authority.
